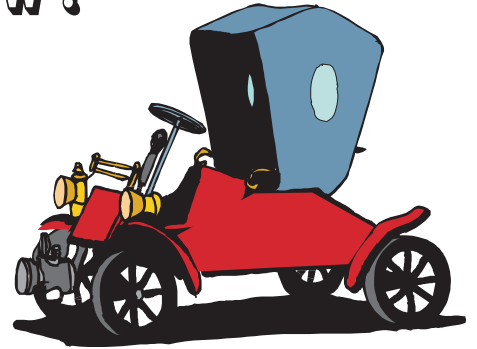
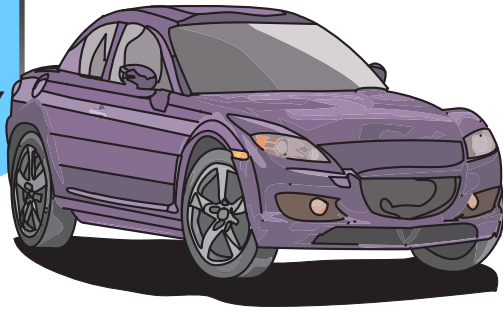




# WHAT WOULD HENRY FORD DO NOW?
